2016 Goals:

- **BRIM –Look for funding to develop a BRIM for local bridge owners. At a past Bridge Committee meeting the Bridge Office introduced their BRIM (bridge replacement and improvement management) process and tool. The BRIM tool uses NBIS inspection and inventory data and input from industry experts to predict the replacement or improvement needs for each bridge on a statewide basis, based on expected deterioration for each bridge. It also uses risk assessment methods to determine the probability of a service interruption, and the consequences of the service interruption (length of detour and potential time to mitigate the service interruption, etc. The BRIM assigns a score to each bridge to represent its relative priority for replacement or improvement.**
- **Local Bridge Oversize/Overweight Permitting-Develop a statewide local bridge permitting process/program to adapt to the current Mn/DOT permitting process, and which will allow seamless permitting between state and local routes.**
- **Bridge Funding Sources, Prioritization, and Trends: Develop special dedicated funding to support a local historic bridge program, incentives to permanently remove deficient local bridges off the inventory, incentives for off-system bridge maintenance, funding local bridge repairs, etc.**
