WHY HSIP?

Why HSIP?

- One of many federal programs that supports traffic safety
- Supports USDOT/FHWA Mission and Policy
 - America has the safest system in the world and
 - Strive for Zero Roadway Deaths
- Concern: Recent increase in fatalities
 - 63% of fatal crashes occur in rural areas (2020 DPS Crash facts)

HSIP Goal:

"Reduce fatalities and serious injuries on ALL public roads"

HSIP Eligible Projects

- Consistent with SHSP
- Selected through Data-Driven approach
 - Proactive or Systemic (CRSP)
 - Reactive
- Focus on Fatality and Serious Injuries
- Open to all public roads
 - Allow cities, counties, tribes and MPOs to participate
 - Deliver webinar annually and invite locals to attend
- HSIP funds can also be used to:
 - Develop local road Safety Plans (CRSP)
 - Engineering Assistance for local roads (PE/CE)
 - In Minnesota use PE/CE assistance for Multi County Projects

Federal Share

- Federal share 90% with 10% Local match
- Certain safety projects are eligible for 100% federal share
 - Can only use 10% of HSIP apportionment
 - FHWA specifies the project types
- HSIP Funds *Can* be used as local match for federal Transportation Alternative (TA) projects
 - MnDOT exploring on how to implement this part of the IIJA
 - Subject to the HSIP solicitation and scoring criteria


HSIP Funded Project Types

- Horizontal curve signs (Chevrons)
- Install/Improve Lighting
- Install/Improve Pavement Marking and/or Delineation
- Install/Improve Signing
- Pavement/Shoulder Widening
- Rumble Strips
- Safety Edge
- Roundabouts 48
- RCI 9







2021 Preliminary numbers





Regional Safety Summit


- Previous Traffic Safety Engagement (2008-2010)
- Fatality numbers increasing
- Loosing momentum
 - Staff Retirement
 - COVID
 - Priorities
- Renew engagement Deliver Regional Safety Summit
 - Engineering focus (not TZD)
 - county engineering staff, planners, construction etc.
 - Include DSAE and district traffic staff
 - Hire consultant (RFP late summer or early fall)
 - Reach all 87 counties, DSAE and district traffic staff
 - Develop outline of the outreach and engagement
 - Listen to local needs and challenges How to reduce K/A crashes
 - Deliver up to two engagement seminar per district
 - collaboratively explore proven infrastructure strategies
- Volunteers needed
 - RFP, development, District related

Apply for HSIP

- Simplified Application Process
 - Proactive projects
 - Reactive Projects
- Simplified Environmental Clearance Bulk Clearance
- Encouraged Cooperation between counties
 - Multicounty or Districtwide projects score higher
- Local match requirements 90% federal / 10% local
- Flexible funding year and higher local match score higher
- Reach out to us to discuss if your project is eligible
 - Help with review of application for completeness
 - Help with prioritization and risk analysis or assignment
 - B/C calculation
 - Help review crash data and interpretation
- More HSIP funds available under IIJA

Participate in CRSP

- Original County Roadway Safety Plan (CRSP)
 - Nations first Local Road Safety Plan
 - Focus on Proactive Safety
 - Supports TZD and SHSP
 - Completed between 2010-2014
- Update started in 2015
 - Phase 1 14 counties
 - Phase 2 17 counties January 2023
 - Phase 3 RFP late 2022 / early 2023
